

Vendor Rules and Regulations

Exhibition Location, Dates and Times:

The 2023 Racial Equity Summit will be held at America's Center Convention Complex in Downtown, St. Louis, at 701 Convention Plaza, St. Louis, MO 63101.

The dates of the summit are Thursday, November 9th, Friday, November 10th, and Saturday, November 11th. The vendor area will be open on Thursday, November 9th from Noon to 5:00pm. Hours on Friday, November 10th are 8:00am-5:00pm, Vendors are required to man their booth areas the entire time to participate in the event. We ask that vendors respect our closing time and are required to breakdown no later than 5:30pm on Friday, November 10th.

While the conference committee will use reasonable efforts to maintain the location, dates, times and floor plans of the 2023 Racial Equity Summit, the committee reserves the right to change any of these at any time and for any reason whatsoever without liability.

Payment Terms: Payment of the vendor space rental fee may be by credit card or check payable to The Community Foundation. We accept the following credit cards – Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express.

Cancellations/Refunds: There are no refunds. Booth spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Priority will be given to major conference sponsors.

Wait List: Orders received after all booths are sold will be placed on a wait list. Vendor Space made available due to booth cancellations will be filled in the order (date & time) that the "Wait List" applicants were received.

Staffing of Vendor Booth: Vendor booths must be staffed at all times during show hours. No Vendor will be permitted to pack, remove or otherwise dismantle their booth prior to the close of the show. Any Vendor breaching this provision may be denied vendor space in future conferences. **Security and Insurance:** Vendors are ultimately responsible for their display and materials. The 2023 Saint Louis Racial Equity Summit, nor the venue, America's Center Convention Complex, assume no responsibility for losses and damages.

Consequently, vendors should take reasonable precautions, including insurance, to protect their property.

In 2019, our community convened at the inaugural **St. Louis Racial Equity Summit** with over 500 attendees. In 2021 over 1,000 individuals came together virtually. This vision imagines a future for St. Louis where, in the generation following the murder of Michael Brown, disparities close, systems thrive, and our region achieves Racial Equity.

This convening will again serve as a platform to elevate, collaborate, and activate the people, practices, and resources necessary to achieve Racial Equity. The 2023 theme is **"Together We Rise: The Power of Community**". The summit has three purposes:

1) Awareness of Inequity: To engage participants in building their awareness of systemic inequities that exist in the regions-- from education to housing to healthcare and beyond.

2) Understanding of Why Inequity Exists: To help participants to gain an understanding of the systemic issues at hand and build a plan for how to address them, perhaps looking at successful tactics in St. Louis or other regions.

3)Transforming Towards Equity: To share ready-made + pressure-tested strategies for taking action. We will look to the leadership of local leaders of color to share actions that can be taken against structural inequities right now.
